



GLOWING OR HIGHLIGHTED SEARCH FIELDS

Fields that are “glowing” or “blue highlighted” in the search criteria section, are fields that have criteria that have been selected in that field. The field changes to a light blue if you have made a selection in that field. This is helpful because it will allow you to identify those fields in which you have made a selection or have input criteria.

In the example below, Status, Property Type, and Bedrooms are all fields that are highlighted in blue to indicate that selections have been made.
